

How to use the COMET V4 interactive screenshot training modules.

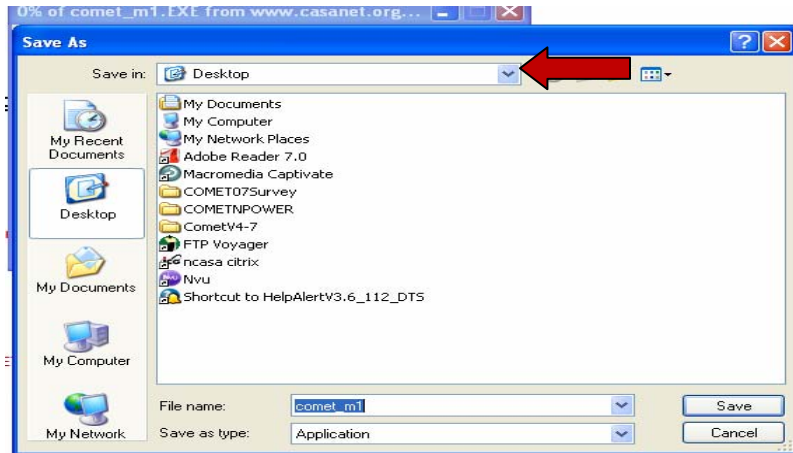

5. Click on "Run" to start the training module.
