

# ***CASA/GAL Mission Statement***

The following are examples of mission statements:

<b>Sample 1</b>	The mission of “CASA/GAL Program” is to provide specially selected and trained community volunteers to advocate for abused and neglected children in the pursuit of safe and permanent homes.
<b>Sample 2</b>	“CASA/GAL Program” provides screened, trained and supervised volunteers who speak up for the needs of children, one child at a time. “CASA/GAL” volunteers, each as an independent voice, advocate for the best interest of abused and neglected children involved in juvenile court deprivation proceedings.
<b>Sample 3</b>	“CASA/GAL Program” is a nonprofit organization, which advocates for the best interests of abused and neglected children within the court system. Based on the belief that children are entitled to a safe and permanent home, “CASA/GAL Program” works in the court system through trained volunteers, in collaboration with key agencies, legal counsel and community resources to serve as the child’s advocates and represent the child in juvenile court.
<b>Sample 4</b>	“CASA/GAL Program” is not-for-profit organization committed to speaking for the best interests of abused and neglected children. “CASA/GAL Program” recruits, trains and supervises volunteers who advocate for this vulnerable population. The “CASA/GAL Program’s” primary goal is to ensure that each and every child is permitted to grow up in a safe and permanent home.
