

**Most recent report of statistical information must be for a specified time period and include:**

Children:

- Demographic information, including age, gender and ethnicity
- Total number of children served
- Number of new children served
- Number of children whose cases were closed

Volunteers:

- Demographic information, including age, gender, ethnicity, education and work status
- Status of volunteers (number assigned to cases, number inactive, number waiting for a case)
- Number of volunteer hours contributed
- Total length of time volunteer is assigned to each case

Other information:

- Types of cases assigned to volunteers
- Type of abuse or neglect in abuse/neglect cases
- Reason for CASA/GAL case closure by the program and court
- Placement of child at time of CASA/GAL case closure by program and court
- Number of children in the court's jurisdiction needing CASA/GAL volunteers versus number of CASA/GAL volunteers assigned to cases
- Case outcomes
- Special data required by specific funding sources

**CASA Program--EXAMPLE

Children Served:

- 126 children served
- 26 new children served
- 22 children's cases closed
- Average age: 10

- Gender: Female - 52%; Male - 48%
- Race/Ethnicity: African-American - 52%; Caucasian - 46%; Hispanic/Latino - 2%

Volunteers:

- Number of volunteers: 62 (58 assigned to cases; 4 inactive)
- Average age: 46
- Gender: Female - 85%; Male -15%
- Race/Ethnicity: Caucasian - 82%; African American - 16%; Hispanic/Latino - 2%
- Education: College graduate - 67%; High school graduate - 24%; Post-graduate degree - 9%
- Employment status - Full-time - 68%; Part-time - 22%; Retired - 6%; Not employed - 4%
- Total number of volunteer hours contributed: 9,672
- Average length of time volunteer is assigned to each case: 26 months

Other Information:

- Types of cases assigned to volunteers: Neglect - 62%; Abuse - 38%
- Type of abuse or neglect in abuse/neglect cases:
  - Neglect
    - Physical - 84%
    - Educational - 8%
    - Medical - 8%
  - Abuse
    - Physical - 78%
    - Sexual - 12%
    - Emotional - 10%
- Reason for CASA/GAL case closure:
  - Family reunification - 72%
  - Adoption - 20%
  - Alternative permanent placement - 4%
  - Other (volunteer no longer able to serve, child placed in another state, etc.) - 4%
- Placement of children at time of case closure:
  - Parents - 64%
  - Relative - 8%
  - Adoptive Home - 20%
  - Foster Care - 8%
- Number of children in the court's jurisdiction needing CASA/GAL volunteers - 450
- Number of CASA/GAL children assigned to volunteers - 126
